Central Plains Mennonite Conference News: In July of this year Jerry Thex, who had taken over as the pastor of the Ashland Christian Fellowship in Montana, informed us that the community no longer had enough people to sustain a church.

There are a lot of different reasons for this and while we are sad about the closing of the church, we praise God for many years of Anabaptist Christian witness in the Ashland community. Scott and Suzette Shreffler from the White River Cheyenne Church and the other members of the Northern Cheyenne Mennonite Churches, along with conference leadership, have been working to figure out what can be done with the property.

At this point, what we need is a group of folks who are interested in heading out to Ashland to **clean up the property**. Scott and a friend went recently and cut back the grass that had grown quite tall, but there is need for a group to clean up brush piles, clean out fence rows and clean up weeds.
